School Uniform Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to inform parents what is expected in terms of appropriate clothing students need to wear while attending school, when on trips, or when engaging in PE activities.

Expectation

Exceptional Ideas does not have a dedicated uniform for students. We believe that therapeutically, uniform causes an unnecessary discomfort to our students.

Students should wear clothing that is appropriate to the weather, comfortable, and that is not offensive to others.

Students should not wear inappropriately revealing clothing, anything with offensive slogans or pictures. They should also not wear shoes that are unsafe; this includes high-heeled shoes or open-toed sandals.

Examples of appropriate clothing

Jogging bottoms, jeans, trousers, skirt, T-Shirt, Sweatshirt.

A wet weather coat will be needed, a hat in summer (with sunblock) and appropriate footwear in wet weather (for example, Wellington boots or similar).

Jewellery should be minimal and not of the type that could get caught in things or pulled to cause harm or injury.

PE wear should consist of a jogging suit and trainers in good condition.
